HAIR/MAKE UP/JEWELRY(GUARD)

- Hair
 - Non Distracting for performances
 - You will be expected to style your hair as instructed for performances. Each season the hair style may change. If you are unsure of how to do your hair, it is your responsibility to ask for help. Your hair should be performance ready by call time.
- Make-up
 - Make-up done as instructed for performances
 - Student responsible to ask for help.
- Jewelry – No jewelry in uniform unless part of the uniform
 - visible body piercings need to be removed
